2025 Legislative Session

The end of the seventh week of the legislative session brings with it the end of almost all committee meetings as well. As a result, many of the committees that met this week had marathon meetings to get bills in the correct posture to be heard on the House and Senate floor.

Sen. Don Gaetz (R-Pensacola) removed the provisions from his charter school bill, SB 140, that would have forced school districts to turn over property to charter school corporations if that property were deemed to be surplus by the State Board of Education. However, the bill still allows public schools to be "converted" to charter schools without the consent of the teachers and staff who work at the school, the school district, or the community at large. This was the last committee stop for SB 140. Its House companion, HB 123 has also passed each of its committees. So, this bill is well on its way to becoming law.

This week in a ceremony that was closed to the public, Gov. DeSantis signed HB 549 into law. This law requires instructional materials and library media center collections adopted after July 1, 2025 to use the term "Gulf of America." The signing of this law is a reminder that even after the legislative session ends, our advocacy must continue. The next Social Studies textbook adoption process will begin in June 2026. This will be a big test of how the FLDOE expects textbook publishers to comply with this law.
